Teen-age Party Ends Rudely, Nudely in Road

What may have been a swinging post-commencement party wound up early today with a group of teenaged barricade buffs placing trash cans across Boxwood Road in front of Henry C. Conrad High School.

They were in the dispassionate words of the police report, words of the police report, partially nude and one of them completely nude" when interrupted in the midst of their 3:30 am activities by a New Castle County patrolman.
